(Pursuant to Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013)

Dear Members,

NOTICE is hereby given to the Members of VINNY OVERSEAS LIMITED (the “Company”) pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 and Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the “Act”) read with Rule 20 and Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (“Rules”), Secretarial Standard-2 on general meeting (the “SS-2”), Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (the “Listing Regulations”) including any statutory modification(s), clarification(s), substitution(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force, guidelines prescribed by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (the “MCA”), for holding general meetings/conducting postal ballot process through e-voting vide General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated 8 April 2020, 17/2020 dated 13 April 2020, 22/2020 dated 15 June 2020, 33/2020 dated 28 September 2020, 39/2020 dated 31 December 2020 and 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021, 20/2021 dated December 08, 2021 (collectively “MCA Circulars”) in view of the current circumstances prevailing due to COVID-19 pandemic and in furtherance to the above said MCA Circulars, the Company will send Postal Ballot Notice only by email to all its shareholders who have registered their email addresses with the Company/ Registrar and Share Transfer Agent (“RTA”) or Depository/ Depository Participants and the communication of assent/ dissent of the Members will only take place through the remote e-voting system. This Postal Ballot process is accordingly being initiated in compliance with the abovementioned MCA Circulars.

The Statement pursuant to Section 102(1) and other applicable provisions of the Act read with the Rules setting out all material facts relating to the resolution mentioned in this Postal Ballot Notice is annexed hereto.

Pursuant to Rule 22(5) of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 the Board of Directors of the Company has appointed M/s Pratik Vora & Associates, Practicing Company Secretary (Member No. A53617/COP: 20569), Practicing Company Secretaries, Ahmedabad, as the Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot (only through Remote E-voting process) in a fair and transparent manner. The proposed Resolution(s) and the Explanatory Statement stating the facts as required in terms of Section 102 and Section 110 of the Act are appended hereto, for your consideration and approval. Members are requested to read and follow the instructions carefully on remote e-voting provided in this Postal Ballot Notice.

The Company has engaged the services of NSDL as the agency to provide e-voting facility.

In accordance with the MCA Circulars, members can vote only through the remote e-voting process. Hence, hard copy of Postal Ballot Notice along with Postal Ballot Form and pre-paid business reply envelope will not be sent to the members for this Postal Ballot. Accordingly, the Company is pleased to provide remote e-voting facility to all its members to cast their votes electronically. Members are requested to read the instructions in the Notes in this Postal Ballot Notice so as to cast their vote electronically not later than 5:00 p.m. IST on Sunday, May 15th, 2022 (the last day to cast vote electronically) to be eligible for being considered.

Items of Special Business requiring consent of shareholders through Postal Ballot:

1. Resolution No. 1- Issue of Bonus Shares.

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as an Ordinary Resolution:

“**RESOLVED THAT** pursuant to the provisions of Section 63 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018, the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“SEBI Listing

Regulations”) and other applicable regulations and guidelines issued by SEBI and Reserve Bank of India (RBI), as amended from time to time, Articles of Association of the Company, subject to such approvals, consents, permissions, conditions and sanctions as may be considered necessary from appropriate authorities and subject to such terms and modifications, if any, as may be specified while according such approvals as may be required in this regard, approval of the members be and is hereby accorded to the Board to capitalize a sum not exceeding Rs. 91,94,600/- (Rupees Ninety One Lacs Ninety Four Thousand Six Hundred Only) or such amount as may be determined to be required by the Board, from and out of the amount standing to the credit of free reserves and/or the securities premium account as at March 31, 2021, be capitalized and transferred to Share Capital Account and that such sum shall be applied for issue of New Equity Shares of the Company of Rs.10/- (Rupees Ten) each as fully paid-up Bonus Shares to the persons who, on the Record Date, shall be holders of the existing Equity Shares of Rs.10/- (Rupees Ten) each of the Company, in the proportion of 1:10 i.e. 1 (One) New fully paid Equity Shares for every 10 (Ten) existing Equity Shares held by such members, for all purposes, be treated as an increase in the paid up Share Capital of the Company held by each such member, and not as income;

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the allotment of the New Equity Shares as Bonus Shares to the extent they relate to Non-Resident Indians (NRIs), Foreign Portfolio Investors (FPIs), Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) and other foreign investors of the Company shall be subject to the approval of the RBI, under the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999, or any other regulatory authority, if applicable and as may be necessary;

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board be and is hereby authorized to take necessary steps for listing of the New Equity Shares on the Stock Exchanges where the securities of the Company are presently listed, as per the provisions of the SEBI Listing Regulations and other applicable guidelines, rules and regulations;

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT no members shall be entitled to a fraction of equity shares as a result of implementation of this resolution of Bonus and no certificate or coupon or cash shall be issued for fraction of equity shares and the bonus shall be rounded to the lower integer. All fractions of bonus equity shares shall be ignored and accordingly the number of issuance of bonus shares may be reduced;
